Our initiatives include


- Full implementation of an inquiry-based spelling program across the school
 - Teacher professional development to support this approach (Kath Murdoch)
 - The purchase of 'Effective Spelling' resources for all classrooms
 - The purchase of data collection tools to monitor spelling achievement progress
- Extending our full school reading program to align further to the Australian Curriculum
 - Teacher professional development at the Reading and Writing Centre
 - Teacher release to collaboratively plan for the literacy demands of each inquiry unit with the Principal
 - Continuation and monitoring of flying-squad strategy for guided reading
